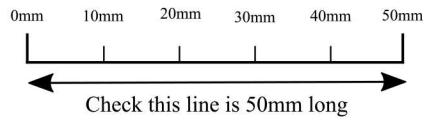


Ring Sizing Tool

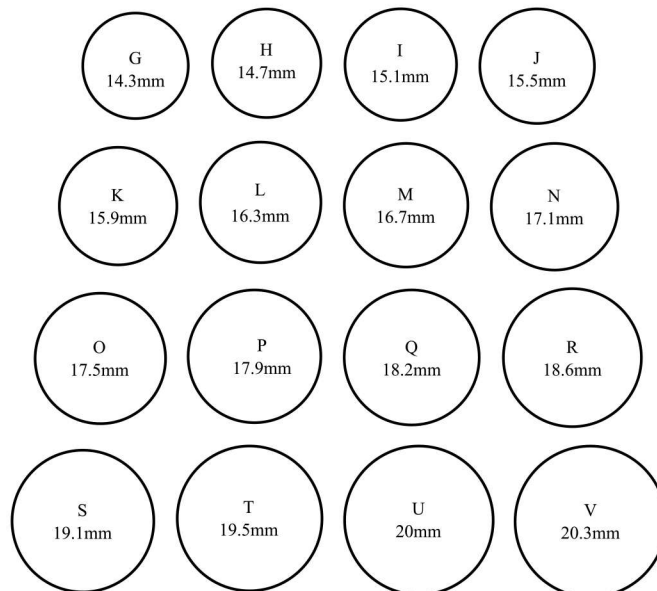
Getting started...

- You will need to print this PDF on A4 paper .
- Check the printing setting and make sure 'scale' is set to 100%.
- Once printed, check the line below is 50mm (5cm) long.



1. Finding out the size of an existing ring...

- Lay your ring over the different sizes in the image below until you find the closest match. The printed line should be just visible on the inside of your ring.



2. Measuring your finger with a cut-out ring sizer...

- Cut out the image below
- Cut along the dotted line (this should make a 'slit' rather than a cut all the way along)
- Loop the tail of the ring sizer around and slot it back through the dotted line slit
- You should now have a loop you can move onto the base of your ring finger
- Pull the loop to the desired tightness around your finger
- The line closest to the dotted line slit indicates your ring size.
